If you pay your bill in person, we accept cash, money orders or checks. We don't recommend putting cash payments in the drop box. "Direct Pay" service is available and if you chose this option, your utility payment would be automatically deducted from your bank account on the 10th of the month.

GARBAGE CARTS:

There is no charge for the garbage carts, and keep in mind that **the cart must remain with the property should you move.**

(If you take the cart, you will be charged for it.) Customers

that pay the family garbage rate will use a larger cart than those that pay the single/senior rate.



All residential garbage collected every Wednesday.

Please follow these directions when using the carts:

- ALL GARBAGE MUST BE IN THE CART.
- Place your cart at the end of your driveway, with the opening of the lid facing the street.
- Allow 3 feet of space around the cart.
- If you have items that won't fit in the cart, they won't be collected with the regular garbage unless other arrangements are made.

Recycling is collected every-other Wednesday according to the attached schedule.

No sorting necessary.
Put all recyclable materials into the cart.

Place your cart at the end of your driveway on the scheduled Wednesdays. Please put with the opening of the lid facing street and allow 3 feet of space around container.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS

Glass bottles and jars, metal beverage and food cans, plastic bottles with narrow necks, paper from news, magazines, junk mail. Dry non-coated food paper box-board, small flat pieces of corrugated cardboard box material.

NOT ACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLES:

Garbage, food waste, diapers, paper plates, plastic bags, wax or plastic wrap or bags, plastic deli products of take-out packaging, wrapping film, Styrofoam packing materials, window glass, ceramics or dishware, mirrors and lightbulbs.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Snow Ordinance:

Snow Removal – It is unlawful for any person to park a vehicle on any street after a continuous or intermittent snow-fall during which there has been any accumulation of two (2) inches or more of snow on any street, until all snow, ice & similar debris has been plowed or removed from the paved portion of the street. All vehicles not removed will be ticketed and/or towed.

Sidewalk Ordinance - Property owners: All ice and snow must be removed from sidewalks within twenty-four (24) hours after the snow or other precipitation causing the condition has ceased to fall. All sidewalks abutting Hwy 56 & 60 between Langford & Spring streets must be clear of all ice and snow within twelve (12) hours.
