

ORDINANCE NO. 94

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1305 OF THE  
KENYON CITY CODE REGARDING WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS  
AND PENALTIES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KENYON, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

**Section 1.** Section 1305.19 of the Kenyon City Code is hereby amended by the addition of the bold and double underlined language and the deletion of the ~~bold and striken~~ language, as follows:

1305.19. Snow removal Winter Parking Regulations. It is unlawful to park a vehicle on a street or highway after a continuous or intermittent snowfall during which there has been an accumulation ~~of two inches or more~~ of snow on any street or highway that requires mobilization of City snow plow crews, and until all snow, ice and similar debris has been plowed or removed from the paved portion of the street or highway. Police officers are hereby authorized to remove, or cause to be removed, a vehicle from a street or highway to the nearest holding facility designated or maintained by the Police Department. The Police Chief, or his or her designee, may issue penalties for removal, as provided by Section 1305.33, in addition to any additional charges, fees, or fines necessary for the removal of the vehicle.

**Section 2.** Section 1305.33, Subdivision 1 of the Kenyon City Code is hereby amended by the addition of the bold and double underlined language and the deletion of the ~~bold and striken~~ language, as follows:

1305.33. Penalty. Subdivision 1. The penalty for violation of subsections 1305.03 to 1305.31, inclusive, is ~~\$25.00~~ \$50.00 if paid within 48 hours, ~~\$50.00~~ \$100.00 if not paid within 48 hours but within one week, and ~~\$100.00~~ \$200.00 if paid after the expiration of one week. Payment must be made at the office of the city administrator. The payee must receive a properly executed receipt after payment of the fine.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication.
